





WI Avg. is \$471, 65% higher than La Crosse \$186 more per person






LA CROSSE COUNTY PROPERTY TAXES ARE ONE OF THE LOWEST IN THE STATE

Average Tax Levy per Capita is \$44.4 Million 34% Higher than La Crosse!


That's \$10.7 Million less Property Taxes per year
